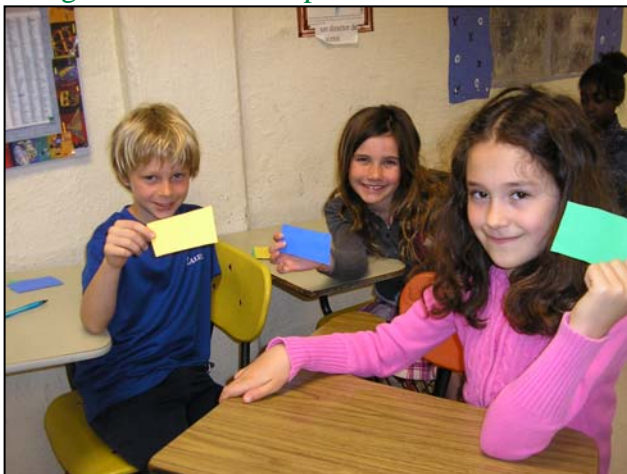

Third Grade

(Two 30-minute classes each week)

The **third-grade students** began the fifth six weeks studying ten Spanish prepositions like near to *cerca de* or far from *lejos de*. They used the prepositions to describe in Spanish the relationships of the eight planets and the minor planet Pluto of the Milky Way to the sun and to each other. Then, in their text and workbook, they learned how to name the special classes at Lakehill and to say what activities they do in each class. With this vocabulary, they wrote a postcard in Spanish to the teacher describing their favorite specials class. Added to this, they practiced matching the subject pronoun to the correct present tense –ar verb form. Best of all, the students enjoyed the rhythm and words of the song “*La bamba.*” The fifth six weeks was busy for third-grade students in Spanish class.
